**On running from God** — ““But Jonah rose up to flee unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord, and went down to Joppa; and he found a ship going to Tarshish: so he paid the fare thereof, and went down into it, to go with them unto Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.” Jonah 1:3

✓ **Household Prayer & Worship**..... Monday-Friday

✓ **Key Word** — “went down” (1:3, 5) “prayer” (2:1, 7)..... Monday

✓ **Conclusion** — God can send storms into our lives to teach us the wisdom of obeying Him. Even though we bring trouble on ourselves by our sin, if we humbly and sincerely pray, He will hear us from His throne of grace and deliver us with His word.
