- ✓ **Memory Verse Power**..... Monday-Friday
On true repentance — “And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that He had said that He would do unto them; and He did it not.” Jonah 3:10

- ✓ **Household Prayer & Worship**..... Monday-Friday

- ✓ **Key Word** — “*repentance*” (vs. 8, 10)..... Monday

- ✓ **Conclusion** — Those who do not desire the eternal judgment of God must repent. God warns so that He will not have to punish, and He makes His judgments conditional upon true repentance. There is mercy for those who will confess and forsake their sin before it is too late.
