4. What three things did God prepare for Jonah, to teach him a truth?
5. How did Jonah show in verse 9 that he hadn’t yet learned the lesson?
6. Explain briefly the lesson God wanted Jonah to learn.
7. Name 6 times God used nature to fulfill His will in the book of Jonah.

✓ **Memory Verse Power**..... Monday-Friday

On loving enemies — “But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you.”

✓ **Household Prayer & Worship**..... Monday-Friday
