- ✓ **Memory Verse Power**..... Monday-Friday
Jesus is our example — *“For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.”*
Hebrews 4:15

- ✓ **Household Prayer & Worship**..... Monday-Friday
* Ask God to help you apply the things He has taught you about temptation.

- ✓ **Key Word** — *“Temptation”* (vs. 4, 10) Monday
