- ✓ **Memory Verse Power**..... Monday-Friday
On our compassionate Lord - “But thou, O LORD, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.”

- ✓ **Household Prayer & Worship**..... Monday-Friday
* Ask God for the faith to believe the promises from his Word.

- ✓ **Key Word** — “*faith*” (vs.52)..... Monday

- ✓ **Conclusion** — Troubles in our lives should drive us to prayer, for it is only persistent and believing prayer that drives trouble and doubt away. There is no way of approach to God on the ground of our own merits, but only on the ground of God’s mercy, as shown at the blood-sprinkled mercy seat. Only then is our faith rewarded on the merits of Jesus Christ.
