3. Why did they feel the need to tell this version of their story?
4. How did the Pharaoh respond to Sarai and her beauty?
5. What happened to the Pharaoh when he took Sarai into his household?
6. How did God protect Abram, Sarai and their descendants despite the lie?
7. What principle can our families learn from this story?

✓ **Memory Verse Power**..... Monday-Friday

On the effects of famine – “And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine was grievous in the land.”

Genesis 12:10

✓ **Household Prayer & Worship**..... Monday-Friday

* Ask God to help your family trust Him and not the world during hard times.

✓ **Key Word** — “*went down*” (12:10)..... Monday

✓ **Conclusion** — Abram’s tent distinguishes him as a pilgrim in a strange land. Those of us who are Christ’s must remain pilgrims, separated from this world. We must find our portion only in Him - not by going “down into Egypt.”
